### **Free Zenith Brass Fall Concert Includes MSU Faculty Brass Quintet**

The Zenith Brass includes 25 top high school brass and percussion players from 15 schools in Oakland and Macomb counties. They will perform their 22<sup>nd</sup> Annual Fall Concert and will feature their Special Guest, the Beaumont Brass faculty quintet from Michigan State University. This free concert will take place at 7 pm on Sunday, November 20 at the Oak Arbor Church, 495 Oak Arbor Cir W, Rochester, MI 48306 (4 miles north of Downtown Rochester.)

The Beaumont Brass has a very busy season this fall representing the MSU College of Music by travelling to New York, Pennsylvania and Ohio to perform concerts at the Julliard School, Manhattan School of Music, Cleveland Institute of Music and Pennsylvania State University. They will perform music from their tour repertoire.

Zenith Brass will perform pieces from major works by Georg Handel, Richard Wagner and Georges Bizet. Also included are marches by Karl King and by John Philip Sousa and original brass pieces by British composer John Ireland and by Royal Oak native James Curnow.
